Ida Tsui actually achieved the top score A* in all of her subjects.

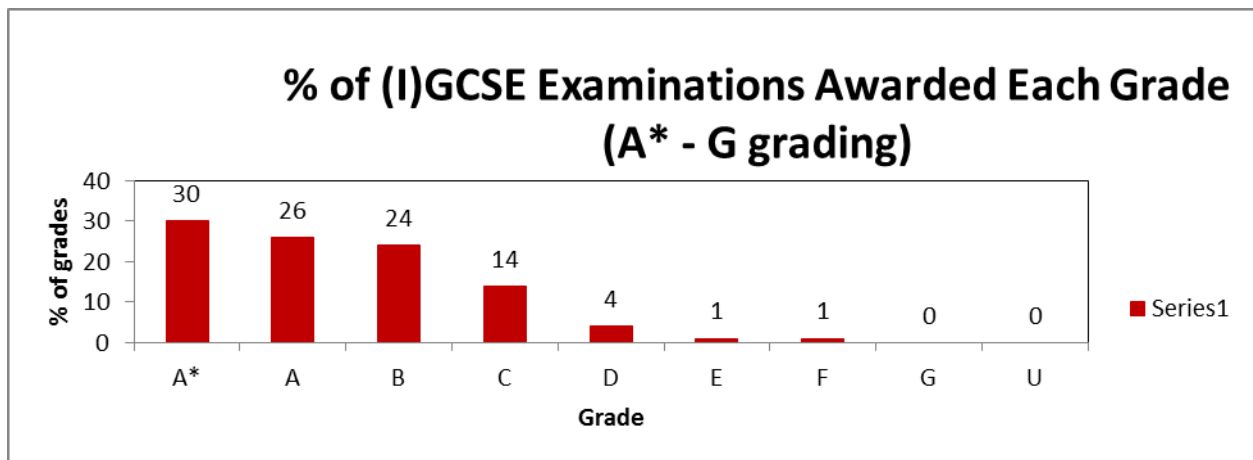
